Furthermore, we hope each presentation will provide an opportunity to exchange information on the quality assurance of education, organizational improvement and university reforms that we faculty members are working on daily.

Therefore, we are calling for practical reports and research reports on FD/SD, such as teaching improvement and work improvement by teaching staff, on a wide range of themes as listed below.

1. The subject line must be "Application for individual presentation at Hokkaido FDSO Forum 2022."

2. It must have the following information:

(1) your affiliation, (2) job title, (3) name, (4) title of presentation and (5) abstract of approximately 200 characters (Japanese) or 120 words (English).

Within three working days of receipt of your application, the person in charge will send you an email confirming receipt of your application with the 'Abstract format' (Word file) attached.

- After being accepted your application, you must submit your Presentation Abstract (using the 'Presentation Abstract Format' attached to the acceptance email)

Deadline: August 24th (Wednesday), 12:00 pm.

The subject line must be "Presentation manuscript for Hokkaido FDSO Forum 2022 (name and affiliation)".

Abstracts should not exceed two pages. The abstracts will be compiled as a book of abstracts and distributed as a file to the participants on the day of the Forum.

Teachers and staff working in higher education institutions and those working in the education industry.

4. Number of invited presentations

18 (on a first-come, first-served basis)

5. Themes

- 1) Practical examples of online teaching
- 2) Student support, learning support and online student support under Corona
- 3) Study abroad under the corona, support for international students
- 4) Examples of remote work and DX promotion
5. Others

6. About the presentations

(1) The order of presentations will be decided by the secretariat based on the outline of the presenter's presentation.

(2) Each presenter has 20 minutes (incl.5 minutes for Q&A) to make a presentation.
